

Junior Livestock Auction

What does it take to get there?

All Junior Exhibitors must do the following:

1. Own their animal for a minimum of 120 days for steers, 60 days for other large animals and 30 days for small animals.
2. Keep project records.
3. Enter their animal in the Fair.
4. Demonstrate and be judged on their Showmanship.
5. Have their animal judged for market quality.



4-H members must:

1. Attend 100% of their animal project meetings and attend at least 80% of their club meetings.
2. Give a presentation during the current 4-H year.
3. Must market their animal to possible buyers - invite buyers to the Auction.
4. Bring their signed project report form, two Buyer Invitations per Animal, Presentation Verification Form (this form is required only if a presentation was given at County Presentation Day) and their Fair entry to the 4-H Office for signature.

FFA members must:

1. Attend at least seven of the nine general meetings.
2. Enroll in Summer School Fitting and Showing Class.
3. Must not miss any classes.
4. Complete a project record book.
5. Market their animal making two buyer contacts per animal.
6. Attend animal weigh-in days.
